### Fact Sheet

**Priority**—Establish, collect, and share best practices for shippers, carriers, regulators, and law enforcement



### Status and Mission

Based on recent discussions with TSUSG committee membership and in consideration of their respective time constraints, the creation of a standing panel of federal agency and laboratory representatives is proposed within PC1 to respond to queries, review proposals, and provide regulatory review of various PC actions. This panel will participate with current TSUSG PC1 members at planned meetings to discuss the status of various PC tasks; review best practices; consider innovative and recommended actions that have been collected; and offer guidance, technical support, and regulatory clarifications as needed. This action is not exclusive as TSUSG hopes to have federal organizations also directly participate with other PCs since their direct involvement will help facilitate a more effective and efficient review and resolution of specific PC issues and actions. Note that the original scope and mission of PC1 was revised to better reflect the ongoing needs of TSUSG, and the aforementioned mandate is best able to meet this need, as agreed upon with TSUSG management and membership.

It is recommended that a panel member (with a designated alternate) be requested to support the TSUSG initiative from each of the following agencies:
