

TSUSG PC 5 Status: Closed Fact Sheet

Priority—Review operational procedures and differences in how escorts are handled from state to state (covert vs. overt) and provide training recommendations



Status and Mission

Using the cross-functional membership of the PC and perhaps of the TSUSG as a whole, identify locations, means and processes by which state law enforcement escorts Category 1 shipments of TSUSG subject radioisotopes.

Guidance for the preceding:

- Determine the scope and outputs of this effort.
- Present this priority item to the CRCPD Board to determine if they
 would like to form a membership task force or work group to
 provide a broad regulatory perspective.
- Coordinate with PC1 and PC3 teams to identify synergies.
- Develop best practices with strong technical support from ORNL.
- Develop plan on how to influence best practices in states.

Key Accomplishments

- Successful collection of information through polling data, interviews, and PC meetings to complete a national overview of current escort activities.
- Integration of CRCPD into the work of this PC through survey and interviews of 31 Agreement State program directors and staff.
- Discussion and related scenario-based interactions amongst committee members to characterize law enforcement response to a transportation security incident.

Next Steps (Ongoing)

- Collate information collected into a report for distribution to TSUSG membership – consider further comments from other TSUSG functional groups (to be completed by 04/22)
- Collate best practices collected from escort and security incident discussions into a report for submittal to the PC1 - (04/22)
