Fact Sheet

Priority—Training opportunities within TSUSG (develop mapping of training needs and requirements to include opportunities for delivery, such as table-top exercises, workshops, etc.)



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Status and Mission

This PC will consider training needs for and from TSUSG that are related to security of transport of radioactive sources. Consideration will be given to mechanisms, facilitators, goals, and objectives for identified training needs.

Guidance on the Preceding

- A. Create a comprehensive guide of existing training resources, programs, availability or restrictions for use, lead organization responsible for the training, cost if any, medium used for training, examination requirements, certifications, length of course, retraining requirements, etc.
- B. Create a training needs synopsis as identified by TSUSG members (this could involve the thoughts of just this PC or a broader survey of the TSUSG membership as a whole) and use the following parameters for recording:
 - Functional group (federal/state government, federal/state law enforcement, industry, carriers)
 - Purpose of training
 - Reason training is required
 - Required content
 - Preferred format/media
 - Course length
 - Examination requirement
 - Potential for more than one functional group benefiting from the training (specify)
 - Etc.
- C. For all courses identified, prepare a high-level course compendium and provide suggested resources that could develop and/or deliver such training.
- D. Consider nontraditional training opportunities such as tabletop exercises, panel discussions, interactive virtual meetings where an issue is raised and participants discuss it with the aid of a facilitator, etc.
