Status and Mission

Finalize the Charter so that it can be used internally and with the public at large. Determine how the Charter can best be communicated to and worked with, when dealing with higher authorities/decision-makers.

Guidance on the Preceding:

- Revisit and refine TSUSG Charter (draft)
- Develop TSUSG organizational structure and identify roles and responsibilities of each (draft)
- Develop a process to review and screen issues that the TSUSG must address to maintain focus and effectiveness
- Develop a review process for TSUSG products (PC outcomes) and their priorities
- Define ongoing activities

Key Accomplishments

- Defined the TSUSG mission resulting in the finalization and formalization of the TSUSG Charter and its corresponding operational procedures.
- Recommended membership roles and qualifications for the members and participants in TSUSG activities.
- Defined the roles and responsibilities for management of and participation in TSUSG activities.
- Approved and finalized the TSUSG Charter within TSUSG management.
- Received ORNL legal review and acceptance of TSUSG Charter and posted on the TSUSG website.
- Actions for use and communication drafted.
- PC 4 concluded (October 2021).
- Final fact sheet developed and approved.
